EEG TEST INFORMATION SHEET

What to expect when having an EEG

Our technician will attached a number of electrodes to your scalp in specific locations.

These electrodes do not transmit any sensation, however simply record your brain waves on our computer equipment. You should feel little or no discomfort during the test which takes up to one hour to complete.

An EEG tracks and records brain wave patterns. Normal electrical activity in the brain makes a recognizable pattern. Through an EEG, doctors can look for abnormal patterns that indicate seizures and other problems.

Preparation for your EEG

Please wash your hair the morning of your EEG but **do not use conditioner** as this may detract from the ability for the electrodes to connect to your scalp.

Please have no product or hairspray in your hair.

Allow 1 hour for this test to be completed.

Do not stop taking any regular medications.
