

PATIENTS HAVING AN EEG TODAY

DRIVING RESTRICTIONS FOR EPILEPSY.

If you are having an EEG today you may be assessed by Dr Pascoe as having epilepsy.

If you are diagnosed with epilepsy there is a mandatory restriction to your Driver's Licence .

Your treating physician is required by Law to report this to the RTA.

If you continue to drive after your licence has been suspended by Dr Pascoe this is a criminal offence.

Your period of driving restriction will be assessed at your consultation and you will be informed.

Your driving restriction will be reported to the RTA. This is a legal requirement.

The time of restriction is decided by RTA Guidelines and not by Dr Pascoe. No discussion about this restriction will be entered into.

Once your epilepsy is stable as determined by Dr Pascoe, your restriction to drive will be reassessed.
